## How to Refer to Baptist Cancer Center Outpatient Infusion

If you are on Epic enter a REF144 Ambulatory Ref to Infusion Center

To expedite, please include an Epic department in your referral. Add BAPT OP Infusion Svcs.

Adding a department ensures the referral leaves your department and goes directly where it needs to go as quickly as possible. Specific provider requests can be placed in the notes.
